#### 2. Size and Weight Restrictions

Aircraft have strict limitations on cargo size and weight. Bulky or oversized items that can easily fit on a container ship may not be transportable by air.

#### 3. Product and Material Limitations

The International Air Transport Association (IATA) imposes strict rules on what can be shipped by air. Items classified as "Dangerous Goods" (DG), such as certain types of batteries, magnets, liquids, and chemicals, require special packaging, documentation, and handling, which adds complexity and cost.

## **Calculating Air Freight Costs from China**

There is no fixed price for international air freight. The final cost depends on several factors, but the most important concept to understand is **chargeable weight**.

Airlines charge based on the greater of two measurements:

- 1. **Actual Weight (Gross Weight):** The weight of the shipment on a scale (in kg).
- 2. **Dimensional Weight (Volumetric Weight):** The amount of space the shipment occupies (its volume).

#### **How to Calculate Chargeable Weight**

To determine the dimensional weight, freight forwarders use a standard formula. The most common is the **1:167 ratio**, which assumes that 1 cubic meter (CBM) of space is equivalent to 167 kg.

• **Formula:** Volume (in CBM) x 167 = Dimensional Weight (in kg)

- Its dimensions are 120cm x 100cm x 100cm, which is **1.2 CBM**.
- Calculate the dimensional weight: 1.2 CBM \* 167 = 200.4 kg.

In this case, the dimensional weight (200.4 kg) is greater than the actual weight (100 kg). Therefore, the airline will charge you for **200.4 kg**. This is the **chargeable weight**.

If the actual weight had been 250 kg, you would be charged for 250 kg, as it would be the higher value.
